



## UHRI's Tribute To Floyd

### Protests Are Inadequate: Just Boot Congress-The Ballot Revolution Begins

In the wake of Floyd's murder, America, divided along racial lines, is on the brink of self-destruction and existential chaos. Americans must resolve to destroy racism now or racism will ultimately destroy America, the 1965 Civil Rights Law, notwithstanding. How do we destroy American racism? Easy. Boot out all 535 members of the Congress that initiated officially sanctioned racism aka "Nation Of European Immigrants." Booting Congress, not protesting the symptom of racism at Congress would give a fresh start to a new America that respects the humanity of everyone.

More than protests, it will take a new American Revolution for the regeneration and rebirth of America. It's time protesters boot the racist Congress and take over to create change. Instead of appealing to Congress, protests must gather signatures for candidates to run for Congress and do the change themselves. Fortunately, unlike Liberia, candidates need thousands of US Dollars to register, there's no fee to run for the US Congress!

George Floyd's gruesome murder was no accident, and Floyd wasn't the only Black person murdered on that day. Across America and in American racist enclaves created by Congress to perpetuate slavery, remove and banish Americans of color such as the American Colony of Liberia and Indian Reservations, murders happen regularly, conveniently out of sight, and out of mind. Floyd's sickening and savage murder happened unhindered, on Memorial Day, May 25, 2020, with police standing by, in broad daylight, on live camera, with witnesses watching in the richest country with the most powerful military on Earth. Why? Or why not? The United States of America, founded by white supremacists stays true to its original purpose; to **steal, kill, and destroy** the lives and livelihood of Americans of color.

Because racism is a living system-a "tree planted by rivers of water," it cannot be reformed or eradicated by mere protests, statements of condemnation, policy changes or new laws. Like cancer, it must be uprooted and cast away and in its place, new seeds of peaceful co-existence must be planted. American Racism was initiated, unprovoked, by people-European Immigrants-white supremacists. The demise of racism must also be initiated by people of all races, who are sick and tired of the cancer of racism.

America's racist system is rotten to the core, corrupt, and broken by design. On March 26, 1790, the racist US Congress passed the original United States Naturalization Law, restricting citizenship only to "...**white persons of good character**...". It may not be on the books today but its impacts remain in force, ravaging the lives of descendants of African Americans and Native Americans banished into Indian Reservations and the American Colony of Black Americans in Liberia. They are still shut out of America, still suffering while racism thrives in America.

On March 3, 1819, the racist US Congress passed a law that made the removal, colonization, and banishment of free Black Americans possible, in partnership with

ruthless American Slaveholders of the American Colonization Society (ACS). 80% of the first batch of American emigrants of color removed and colonized in Africa died of malaria. White men were imported to govern the banished African Americans colonized in Liberia for two decades because Blacks were considered inferior and incapable of self-government.

Congress has been complicit in ongoing tortures, massacres, rapes, and corruption in Liberia, conveniently out of sight of American Media. The American Embassy in Liberia discriminates against Liberian visa applicants, making Liberia, the 4th worst visa refusal country in the world. Liberian Refugees, including women and children airlifted by US Marines during Operation Shining Express to safety in America, were denied access to humanitarian assistance for decades until the Liberian Refugee Fairness Act signed into law by President Trump in December 2019. Even with the new law, America is imposing thousands of dollars in filing fees for green cards on unemployed Liberian Refugees, contrary to section 245(i) of the Immigration and Nationality Act of the United States of America, that exempts refugees from paying filing fees for adjustment of status.

On May 28, 1830, President Andrew Jackson signed into law a bill passed by the racist US Congress to remove and banish Native Americans who have lived in America for thousands of years because their color disqualified them from being Americans. Thousands of Native Americans died along the Trail of Tears during the removal-an ongoing crime against humanity! Congress is yet to mitigate this horrible crime against humanity.

A member of the ACS, President Andrew Jackson championed another disastrous removal of Americans- The Indian Removal Act of 1830. Some 100,000 tribesmen were forced to march westward under U.S. military coercion in the 1830s; up to 25 percent of the Indians, many in manacles, perished en route. "By persuasion and

force, they have been made to retire from river to river and from mountain to mountain, until some of the tribes have become extinct and others have left but remnants to preserve for awhile their once terrible names. Surrounded by the whites with their arts of civilization, which by destroying the resources of the savage doom him to weakness and decay. “ President Andrew Jackson 1829.

The 2nd annual report of the American Colonization Society clarified why African Americans were colonized using American Taxpayers money: “*...as is most confidently believed, the colonization of the free people of color, will render the slave who remains in America more obedient, more faithful, more honest, and, consequently, more useful to his master, is it proper to regard this happy consequence to both, as the sole object which the Society hope to attain...*”

Meanwhile, every year one million new immigrants ignorant of the atrocities and racism upon which this nation was built are added to the population to keep the wheels of the racist industry turning. Still, the torture, dehumanization, murders and banishment continues unabated in secrecy, in Liberia and Indian Reservations, where the descendants of those whose ancestors' blood, sweat and tears built America are banished and forgotten.

Calling for police reform or new policies in the wake of Floyd's demise makes no sense because such pleas only perpetuate racism. Without public confession, repentance, atonement, and reasonable restitution for the theft and atrocities against Native Americans and African Americans at the inception of this country. Not only were indigenous Americans massacred and African Americans lynched, but there are also ongoing atrocities against descendants of African tribes languishing in the American Colony of Liberia conveniently hidden out of sight and out of the views of American media and Consciousness. Mired in systemic racism embedded in the foundation of America, the US Congress is totally incapable of eradicating racism or doing anything

concrete to mitigate the ongoing negative impact on descendants of Native Americans and African Americans banished from the land of their birth by racist acts of Congress.

Booting the entire class of the 'do nothing'-Congress is the only way out of racism. It's easy. Compared to the millions protesting worldwide, the 535 members of the current class of Congress are completely outnumbered. The new Congress must focus on creating a new system that respects all of humanity, confesses the sins of racism-repent, and make restitution to Liberia and the 574 Native American Nations banished illegally by a racist Congress.

Booting Congress by running for Congress in the name of Floyd must be the new order of business for protesters. Last year in Boston, a friend of mine won by one vote to become a city councilor only because she ran for office. Two years ago another friend of mine lost a seat he had won for decades in an election where the turnout was only 11%. Most Americans don't vote. While protests after mass shootings at Columbine, Newtown, and Florida yielded nothing, gathering signatures for revolutionary candidates during the Floyd Global Protests to boot out every elected official within the current racist system is destined to destroy racism. Let's go and boot occupants of the White House, Congress, statehouses and city halls in the name of Floyd.
